- Meet with Ms. Enriquez (Counselor) or Dr. Manning (dual credit liaison) to sign <u>Dual Credit Student Responsibilities Agreement</u> and the Life School Transportation Acceptable Behavior Agreement
- Work with high school counselor to enroll in appropriate classes

TSI Exemptions:

- ACT: Composite score of 23 with a minimum of 19 on the English test shall be exempt for both the reading and writing sections of the TSI Assessment, and/or 19 on the mathematics tests shall be exempt for the mathematics section of the TSI Assessment.
- **SAT**: A minimum score of 480 on the Evidenced-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) test shall be exempt for both reading and writing sections of the TSI Assessment; a minimum score of 530 on the mathematics test shall be exempt for the mathematics section of the TSI Assessment.
