- Must meet Dual Credit Criteria found in the Course Guide on pg. 21-
 - Pass all MS and/or HS classes
 - Pass all STAAR/EOC assessments
- Meet all entrance requirements for Dallas College
- Complete all steps in the Dual Credit Admissions Process

- Meet with Ms. Enriquez (Counselor) or Dr. Manning (dual credit liaison) to sign [Dual Credit Student Responsibilities Agreement](#) and the Life School Transportation Acceptable Behavior Agreement
- Work with high school counselor to enroll in appropriate classes

Required TSI Scores as of 1/11/2021

TSIA2 ELAR STANDARDS

ELAR Score of 945+ AND Essay Score of 5-8 OR,
ELAR Score below 945 AND ELAR Diagnostic Level of 5-6 AND Essay score of 5-8

TSIA 2 Math STANDARDS

Math 950+ OR,
Math below 950 AND Math diagnostic level of 6

TSI Exemptions:

- **ACT:** Composite score of 23 with a minimum of 19 on the English test shall be exempt for both the reading and writing sections of the TSI Assessment, and/or 19 on the mathematics tests shall be exempt for the mathematics section of the TSI Assessment.
- **SAT:** A minimum score of 480 on the Evidenced-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) test shall be exempt for both reading and writing sections of the TSI Assessment; a minimum score of 530 on the mathematics test shall be exempt for the mathematics section of the TSI Assessment.
