



Student Driver Information

Vehicles parked on school property are under the jurisdiction of the school. The school reserves the right to search any vehicle if reasonable cause exists with or without the presence of the student. Students are responsible for any prohibited objects or substances, such as alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and weapons that are found in the cars and will be subject to disciplinary action.

Students should park their cars immediately upon arrival at school and not use/enter them until the time of departure from campus at the close of the school day. Students are not to sit in parked cars on the campus at any time. Students who enter their vehicles or go to the student parking lot during this time without permission may be assigned discipline consequences that may include loss of parking privileges.

Student parking privileges are restricted to the following regulations:

- Students must park only in their designated numbered parking spot with the number that matches their parking hang tag during school hours.
- Students who park in unassigned numbered parking spots will be subject to disciplinary action.
- Vehicles parked in unassigned areas or otherwise improperly parked are subject to being towed at the owner's expense.
- All student cars must be registered in the high school office with current insurance and driver's license on file.
- All student cars will be required to display a current student parking hangtag, acquired from the high school office for **\$20.00**. Any student whose car does not display such a hangtag will be subject to disciplinary action, and the vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Extreme violations will result in suspension of driving privileges at Life High School Waxahachie.
- Students who lose their hangtag will have to pay \$10.00 for a replacement.
- Students must obey all traffic regulations. Rules are to be observed at all times while the vehicle is on school property.
- School administrators may search vehicles. Anything found in a vehicle driven to school by a student is considered to be in the possession of a student.
- Students leaving without the school's written permission will be subject to loss of parking

privileges; and/or disciplinary measures as deemed appropriate by the principal.

- No refunds will be given as a result of a permit being revoked.

STUDENT DRIVER INFORMATION

Life High School is a closed campus. Students who are assigned an EARLY RELEASE are not allowed to stay on campus waiting for siblings or carpool. If you have siblings to pick up you will need to come back during regular dismissal time and go through the pickup line. Students leaving for an appointment must have written permission by parent or legal guardian before receiving their permit to leave campus from the front office. Students leaving without parent permission and signing out in the High School office will be subject to disciplinary actions. Students are not authorized to drive on campus until the **STUDENT DRIVER INFORMATION FORM** is signed and returned along with the \$15.00 fee and a copy of the **STUDENT'S DRIVER LICENSE AND INSURANCE CARD**.

- Drivers license uploaded(hangtags will not be issued to permits)
- Current Insurance uploaded
- \$20 fee paid(link will be provided after students submit form)
